Purpose:

To provide all students interested in pursuing a career with a CA firm the opportunity to gather information and meet representatives from firms that will be recruiting in the 2010-11 year. Keep in mind that recruiting CA firms will use this as an opportunity to meet potential summer or permanent candidates in an informal setting.

Tips & Advice:

- dress as you would for an interview
- do your research on the firms; use this information to express your interest in their firm
- be prepared to discuss:
 - why you are interested in becoming a Chartered Accountant
 - your previous work experience
 - extracurricular activities
 - future goals and aspirations
- ask questions to further demonstrate your interest
- ask for a business card
- do not ask questions about salary or benefits; wait until you are being considered as a candidate

Sample Questions to Ask:

Have some questions ready to ask the recruiter such as:

- What is the employment outlook for someone entering the field right now?
- What type of assignments are given to summer students or new graduates?
