### **Job Summary:**

Community based clinical nutrition services are the primary focus of this position. The role of the dietitian ensures that the nutrition needs of all clients in Sunrise Health Region South are met through providing nutrition assessment and counseling to inpatients in acute care facilities, residents in long term care facilities and outpatients as requested by physicians and through nutrition information resources and classes. The dietitian also acts as a consultant to staff for all nutrition related concerns and advisory to the Food Service Manager in any food service matter in which he/she can offer assistance.

- Successful completion of an approved dietetic internship or equivalent
