POSITION: Full-time Coaches – Coach Program

SUMMARY: COACH is an innovative multidisciplinary program managed by Winnipeg School Division and Macdonald Youth Services and is housed in the West Broadway area. It is designed primarily to assist 6 - 11 year old children who, because of longstanding and pervasive behavior disorders, have not been able to be maintained in the existing educational system. COACH is a therapeutic program whose goal is to return children to an educational setting through providing educational family based and community interventions. The successful applicants are responsible for providing daily implementation of behavioral, family support, and recreational community components of a 24-hour treatment plan. The Coaches will report to a COACH supervisor and will work under the direction of the classroom teacher during school hours. These positions involve working primarily day shifts with some weekends and evenings (as needed).

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Reporting to the COACH Program Manager the successful applicant will work with children on a multi-disciplinary team on a daily basis both in the classroom and community setting; Develop and implement community based activities, including summer program.

QUALIFICATIONS NECESSARY TO DO THE JOB:

- Degree or Diploma in an applicable Human Services or related field;
- Must possess a valid Driver's License, reliable vehicle and required insurance;
- First Aid / CPR certificate required within the first three months of employment.

PREFERRED REQUIREMENTS:

- Two years supervised experience working with families and children with behavioral issues high needs;
- Knowledge of child development and family systems;
- Experience working on a multidisciplinary team;
- Current non-violent crisis intervention certificate;
- Knowledge of aboriginal culture and language would be an asset.
