- ❖ A B.Ed. Degree*
- ❖ A valid teaching certificate*
- ❖ Normally, a minimum of two years teaching experience
- ❖ Two letters of reference, attesting to character, teaching ability, and scholarly aptitude
- ❖ A minimum grade point average of 3.0
- ❖ Competence in spoken and written English
- ❖ International students must submit a TOEFL score of at least 580 (paper-based) or 237 (computer-based)
- ❖ Pre-Admissions Writing Test

* Only in exceptional circumstances will students without a B.Ed. degree be considered for admission. Applicants with a relevant undergraduate degree and professional experience may apply.

Deadlines

Applications are due April 1st and October 1st of each year.

All supporting documents must be included in the application. Only complete applications will be considered.

Course work must be completed within six years, with an additional two years to complete a project or an additional three years to complete a thesis.
