- ❖ A B.Ed. Degree\*
- ❖ A valid teaching certificate\*
- ❖ Normally, a minimum of two years teaching experience
- ❖ Two letters of reference, attesting to character, teaching ability, and scholarly aptitude
- ❖ A minimum grade point average of 3.0
- ❖ Competence in spoken and written English
- ❖ International students must submit a TOEFL score of at least 580 (paper-based) or 237 (computer-based)
- ❖ Pre-Admissions Writing Test

\* Only in exceptional circumstances will students without a B.Ed. degree be considered for admission. Applicants with a relevant undergraduate degree and professional experience may apply.

## Deadlines

Applications are due April 1<sup>st</sup> and October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.

All supporting documents must be included in the application. Only complete applications will be considered.
