- Alexander Doreen Fedoruk Sym Memorial Scholarship** – To be awarded to a student who has completed a minimum of one year of studies (24-36 credit hours) at Brandon University, and who has been accepted into a Social Work program at an accredited institution. .... **\$775**
- Bank of Montreal Scholarship** – To be awarded to a student enrolled full-time in any degree program at Brandon University ..... **\$1,500**
- Brandon Chamber of Commerce Scholarship** – To be awarded to a second year student proceeding to third year who has declared his/her major, or minor in Business Administration and who has achieved a minimum 3.0 gpa in his/her coursework in Business Administration. The student also must have participated in activities which demonstrate leadership and community involvement. Two letters of reference will be required to support the application. - Disaster Recovery Information Exchange (DRIE) Scholarship**– To be awarded on the basis of academic achievement to a student enrolled in the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year of the Applied Disaster and Emergency Studies program at Brandon University. A letter of support indicating off campus involvement in the area of Disaster Management is required. .... **\$500**
  
- Dr. Mieczyslaw Kozakiewicz and Marian Thomas Kozakiewicz Scholarship**– To be awarded, normally on a rotating basis, to a student in one of the following programs of study: a) a student at Brandon University who has been accepted into a graduate program in environmental studies at a Canadian University; b) a Brandon University student who has been accepted into first year Medicine at a Canadian University; c) a student pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Nursing at Brandon University; d) a 3<sup>rd</sup> year student proceeding to the fourth year in History at Brandon University. For the 2008-9 Academic year, this scholarship will be awarded to a student at Brandon University who has been accepted into a graduate program in Environmental Studies at a Canadian University... **\$1200.**
  
- Dr. Wilfred W. McCutcheon Scholarship in Education** – Initiated by the Alumni Teacher Training classes and Education I and IA classes of 1956-1967. This scholarship is to be awarded to a student in the Faculty of Education (A.D.) who demonstrates a combination of outstanding academic achievement, excellence in leadership ability on campus or in the community, and professional promise in classroom teaching. The student must have a minimum 3.50 g.p.a. in the pre-award year and provide two letters of recommendation from the Dean and/or members of the Faculty of Education ..... **\$2,400**
  
- Esuke Toke Memorial Scholarship**– To be awarded to an International student based on academic merit after his/her first year of studies at Brandon University ..... **\$TBA**
  
- Gary & Fanny Cristall Memorial Scholarship** – To be awarded to a student who has completed not less than 54 credit hours of study, with a major or minor in the Humanities and/or Social Sciences and who has obtained at least a 3.0 c.g.p.a The recipient must be pursuing studies in the Humanities and/or Social Sciences related to the history of labour and/or the development of political or cultural issues. Applicants must submit an outline as to how their studies relate to the history of labour and/or the development of political or cultural issues..... **\$1,484**
  
- Gerdau MRM Steel Inc. Annual Scholarship** – To be awarded with preference given to children of employees of Gerdau MRM Steel Inc. or to an undergraduate Aboriginal student who shows outstanding performance in his/her studies. .... **\$1,000**
  
- Gol Aidun Memorial Scholarship**– To be awarded to a Visa (International) or refugee student who has finished First Year studies and is proceeding to Second Year studies at Brandon University. He/she must have a high academic standing and have participated in extra -curricular activities demonstrating involvement, leadership or organizational skills promoting the welfare of international students. - Jay Te Winburn Scholarships** – These awards are intended to fund exceptional opportunities for exceptional students. The student(s) must have either graduated from an accredited high school in Western Manitoba, or have primary residence in Western Manitoba while attending secondary school elsewhere. The student(s) must also be returning to full-time studies at Brandon University for at least one semester. Exceptional opportunity is meant to imply rare and unusual opportunities not ordinarily offered to Brandon University students such as (but not limited to) students wishing to spend a semester or a summer at a world-class university or institution in a foreign country. Grade point average will not be the sole criterion for the award. The value and number of awards will vary based on available funds and the nature of the opportunity. - Koop and Thiessen Families Scholarship** – To be awarded to an outstanding rural student in the School of Music program at Brandon University. Preference will be given to an individual who is a single custodial parent ..... **\$800**
  
- Manitoba Government Employees Association BUNASA Local 2003 Scholarship** – To be awarded to a dependent of a Brandon University MGEU member who is entering any Faculty at Brandon University with the highest proficiency in her/his Senior 4 studies. - Manitoba Rural Initiatives Undergraduate Scholarship in Rural & Community Studies** -To be awarded to an undergraduate student from rural Manitoba who is enrolled in the Rural & Community Studies Program at Brandon University. - Merv Bolley Scholarship in Business Administration** – To be awarded to a full or part-time student upon application, who is pursuing the Bachelor of Business Administration degree program at Brandon University and who shows a combination of outstanding academic performance and community involvement. Preference for this scholarship will be given to present and past employees of Outdoor Box Office, the Keystone Centre or the Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba and their families. The student must present letters of reference describing the student’s involvement and present evidence of his/her, or a family member’s employment with one of the above organizations. - Mr. Sub Scholarship** – To be awarded to a Business Administration student who demonstrates high academic standing and community involvement. A letter of recommendation must accompany the student’s application form ..... **\$500**
  
- President’s Leadership Scholarships** – To be awarded to continuing students of academic proficiency who have made exemplary contributions to their academic institutions and community and who have demonstrated the potential to become leaders in society. Students are required to submit with their application form a covering letter which describes their contributions and leadership skills, a resume and two letters of reference from reputable members of their community ..... **\$tuition x 2**
  
- R.J. McCarthy Memorial Scholarship**– To be awarded to a Mature student in First Year who wishes to continue studies towards the degree of Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, or Bachelor of Music at B.U. The student must have participated in activities beneficial to the institution and have achieved academic excellence as a full-time student. .... **\$461**
  
- Simplot Canada Limited Scholarship**– The Company makes available each year one entrance or undergraduate scholarship to children of employees through its Scholarship program. The student must have a minimum 3.5 g.p.a. in the pre-award year and provide two letters of recommendation from the Dean and/or members of the Faculty of Education **\$2,400**
  
- Donna and Bill Parrish Scholarship for Aboriginal Students** – To be awarded to an Aboriginal student of strong academic merit enrolled in full-time study at Brandon University ..... **\$1500**
  
- Isabelle Douglas Estate Scholarships** – To be awarded to a second or third year student proceeding to third or fourth year studies in any degree program at Brandon University being taken on or off campus. - Louis Riel Scholarships** – For Manitoba residents of Metis status. (Please contact the Senate Scholarship Office for separate application forms for these scholarships) ..... **\$1,500 x 6**
  
- Mervin & Barbara Tiller Scholarship for Aboriginal students** – To be awarded to an Aboriginal student enrolled in full-time study at Brandon University. Preference will be given to a major or minor in Business Administration, Computer Science, Education (B.G.S./B.Ed. A.D. or A.D.), First Nations and Aboriginal Counselling or Health Studies

- MTS (Manitoba Telecom Services Inc.) Scholarship for an Aboriginal student** – To be awarded to an Aboriginal student taking courses in computer science or business administration. - Manitoba Teachers’ Society Bursary for an Aboriginal Student** -To be awarded on the basis of financial need to a full-time Aboriginal student who is enrolled in an undergraduate program in the Faculty of Education at Brandon University. Students may not receive the Manitoba Teachers’ Society Bursary and the Manitoba Teachers’ Society Bursary for Aboriginal students within the same year. **\$2400**
  
- MTS (Manitoba Telecom Services Inc.) Bursary for an Aboriginal student** -To be awarded to an Aboriginal student taking courses in computer science or business administration. In the event that there are no qualified candidates, the award will be granted to any Aboriginal student in a Science program. - Scotiabank Scholarship for Aboriginal Students in financial need** – To be awarded to an Aboriginal student who demonstrates financial need and satisfactory performance. - Barbara Bailey Scholarship/Bursary in Voice** -To be awarded to a Brandon University student who is enrolled as a Voice Major in the School of Music on the basis of financial need and musical merit. .... **\$1000**
  
- Barrie and May Burch Award in Geology** -To be awarded, based on financial need, to an outstanding full-time Geology major student who is proceeding into second year. .... **\$TBA**
  
- Beatrice and Gunnar Wickman Bursary in Nursing** -To be awarded on the basis of financial need to a second year student who has completed the Medical Nursing for Psychiatric Nurses course (69:263 or its equivalent) and is pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Psychiatric Nursing (B.Sc.P.N.) program at Brandon University ..... **\$TBA**
  
- Birks Family Foundation Bursary** -To be awarded on the basis of financial need to deserving full-time students pursuing an undergraduate academic degree. The Foundation wishes to lend its support to those students who can be expected to make positive contributions to society if given the opportunity to complete their studies ..... **\$1000**
  
- Boom & Ellie Cristall Bursary** - To be awarded to a full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate student in financial need. Applicants will provide written proof that the family member was a member of the Brandon Elks Lodge #14; b) has a physical or learning disability; or c) is enrolled in an academic program that could lead directly or indirectly to acquiring skills necessary to work with visually and/or learning impaired children. Students must apply by the required deadline and be currently enrolled in the next year of the program.

- Brandon Regional Health Center Auxiliary Bursary** -To be awarded to a student from Brandon or rural Manitoba, on the basis of financial need and academic merit, to a post-diploma Bachelor of Science in Nursing student or to a student who has successfully completed Year 2 of the Bachelor of Nursing program and who is currently enrolled in Year 3 of the program at Brandon University. **\$1000 x 2**
  
- Brandon Regional Health Center Auxiliary Bursary** - To be awarded to a student from Brandon or rural Manitoba, on the basis of financial need and academic merit, to a post-diploma Bachelor of Science in Mental Health student or to a student who has successfully completed Year 2 of the Bachelor of Science in Psychiatric Nursing program and who is currently enrolled in Year 3 of the program at Brandon University ..... **\$1000.**
  
- Brandon University Alumni Association Award in the Faculty of Arts** – To be awarded to a student entering his/her final year of a Bachelor of Arts degree who has a minimum 3.0 gpa and a financial need ..... **\$2000**
  
- Brandon University Alumni Association Award in the Faculty of Education** – To be awarded to a student entering his/her final year of a Bachelor of Education After Degree who has a minimum 3.0 gpa and has a financial need ..... **\$2000**
  
- Brandon University Alumni Association Award in the Faculty of Science** – To be awarded to a student entering his/her final year of a Bachelor of Science degree who has a minimum 3.0 gpa and a financial need. .... **\$2000**
  
- Brandon University Alumni Association Award in the School of Health Studies** – To be awarded to a student entering he/her final year of either a B.Sc.P.N. or B.N. degree program who has a minimum 3.0 gpa and has a financial need ..... **\$2000**
  
- Brandon University Alumni Association Award in the School of Music** – To be awarded to a student entering his/her final year of a Music degree who has a minimum 3.0 gpa and a financial need..... **\$2000**
  
- Brandon University Centennial Bursaries** - A student who receives a Board of Governors Entrance Scholarship may be granted a Centennial Bursary. - Brandon University Students' Union Bursaries (Open to all faculties.)** - Awarded to students with financial need who are continuing their studies at B.U. .... **\$1000 to be divided**
  
- Brandon University Students' Union Leadership Bursaries** - Awarded to a student who demonstrates satisfactory academic performance and had at least one year's involvement in activities on the Brandon University campus, either at the club level or through involvement with the Students' Union or related organizations. The applicant must provide two Letters of Reference ..... **\$250 x 2**
  
- Breneman Family Scholarship/Bursary** -To be awarded to a student from rural western Manitoba entering his/her first or a subsequent year at Brandon University, who has achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (or an equivalent high school average) and who has demonstrated financial need. A letter of recommendation indicating community service is also required..... **\$1000**
  
- Burton Henry Taylor Memorial Bursary in Pre-Medicine** - To be awarded to a student who has completed the First year and indicates intention to complete the requirements for entry into medicine ..... **\$984**
  
- Campbell Bursary in Geology** – to be awarded to a full-time student enrolled as a major in second year Geology courses on the basis of financial need. Award may not be shared.....**\$TBA**
  
- Canadian Federation of University Women, Brandon Branch, Bursary** -To be awarded to a female student with a financial need entering her second year of studies. Preference will be given to students twenty-one years of age or older. Students who have held the award may reapply in a subsequent year, but preference will be given to new applicants..... **\$500**
  
- Clotilde Bursary in Statistics** -To be awarded to a student who demonstrates financial need and has received a grade of “B” or more in the Brandon University course 62:171 (Introduction to Statistics). In case of equal financial need, the bursary will be awarded to the student who received the higher mark. This award may not be shared.....**\$TBA**
  
- Dave S. Weiss Family Bursary** – To be awarded to a full-time student who is continuing his/her studies at Brandon University and who demonstrates a financial need and registers in the Faculty of Science ..... **\$1124**
  
- Desrosiers Family Bursary** -To be awarded with preference given to a first-year or part-time student from Manitoba on the basis of financial need who is attending Brandon University ..... **\$756**
  
- Disaster Management Conference Bursary** – To be awarded to an undergraduate student on the basis of academic performance and financial need, who is enrolled in the Applied Disaster and Emergency Studies (A-DES) program at Brandon University ..... **\$2000**
  
- Don Raleigh Bursaries in Music and Geology** - One award to be given annually to a student who is a full-time major or minor in Geology, and one award to be given annually to a student who is a full-time Music student, on the basis of financial need ..... **\$TBA x 2**
  
- Donald E. Blaikie & D. Ralph Blaikie Scholarship** – To be awarded to an undergraduate student on the basis of academic merit and financial need, who is enrolled in a minimum of 3 credit hours/term in any faculty at Brandon University. Preference will be given to a single parent or a full-time working

student (approx. 30 hours/week). This award is renewable. Recipients must reapply each year to demonstrate continuing qualifications. The award is granted over 2 terms. The student must demonstrate continued eligibility for second term renewal. ....\$TBA

**Dorothy E. Stewart (Davis) Memorial Bursary in Health Studies** -To be awarded to a full-time student in the Bachelor of Nursing Degree who has financial need, has demonstrated outstanding clinical and academic achievement in the second year of the Bachelor of Nursing program and is currently enrolled in the third year of the Bachelor of Nursing program.....\$2500 x 2
