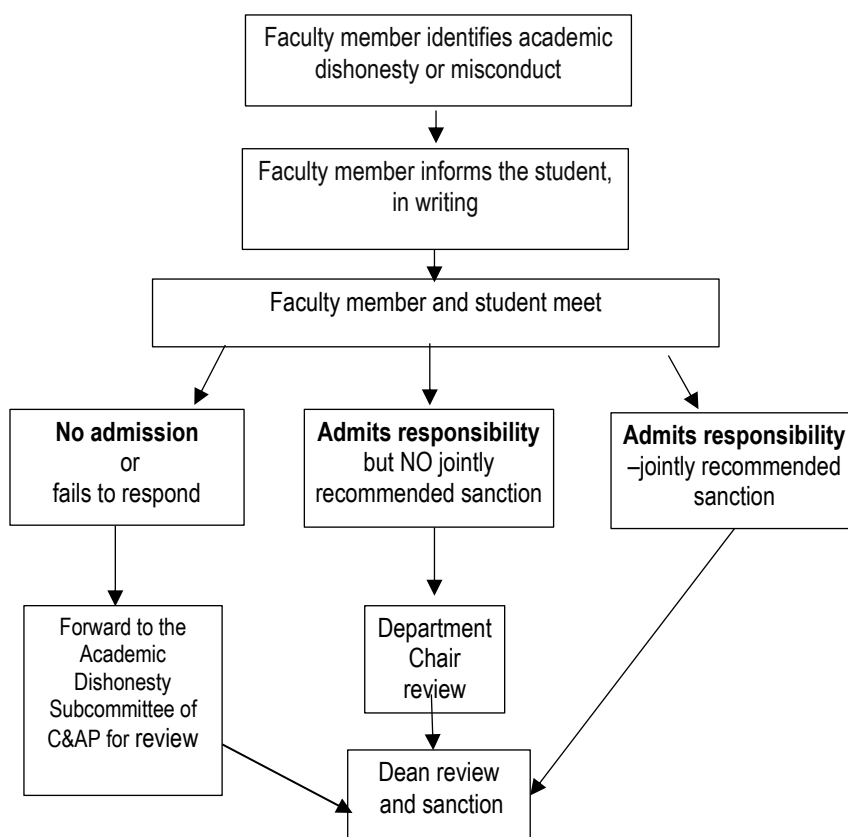


Academic Integrity
