1.0 Policy General Purpose

The purpose is to identify the duties, composition and terms for this committee.

2.0 Policy Guidelines

Duties:

The Admissions Committee will recommend policy on matters of admission and readmission to the Dean and Faculty. Each year, the Committee will select from the applicants to the program in keeping with the policy and direction from Faculty.

Composition:

The Admissions Committee will consist of at least two Faculty members per stream elected by Faculty. The Committee may add other members to the committee to carry out the admission decision-making process.

Term:

Faculty members will be elected for a 2-year term. Terms of members will be staggered.
