1.0 Policy Guidelines

Full-time Students

Refer to the Graduate Calendar, section 3.4.1

Time to Completion

Graduate students in the Master’s in Education program must complete all program requirements for course or thesis route within a maximum time limit of six years starting with the date of their first course, or from date of admission to program (which ever comes first).

A first extension to the time limit may be granted to the student in exceptional circumstances, subject to the recommendation of the appropriate department /school/faculty. An additional extension request would require the recommendation and approval of both the Graduate Education Committee and Senate Graduate Studies Committee. The decision from the Senate Graduate Studies Committee is final and shall be communicated in writing.
