### 1.0 Policy General Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to describe an option for further studies after graduating with a first M.Ed. degree.

### 2.0 Policy Guidelines

The requirements for a second Master of Education degree from Brandon University are as follows:

- Students who have obtained their first M.Ed. degree (36 credit hours) from Brandon University must complete, for a second M.Ed. degree, a minimum of 24 additional credit hours that include required course work in the new specialization; and any remaining electives.
