- A minimum 2.50 (C+) GPA in both course work for both degrees (B.A. and B.Ed.)
- B. A. with Liberal Arts Distributed Major completed
- 24 Credit hours of Core Requirements, including:
  - 6 credit hours in English Literature (or French Literature, not a combination)
  - 6 credit hours in Math (including 62.152 Contemporary Math)
  - 6 credit hours in Science (Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics, Astronomy)
  - 6 credit hours of History and/or Geography
- Two teachable subjects completed in your Liberal Arts degree (18 credit hours and 12 credit hours – note that “D” grades are not accepted towards teachable subjects)
- Completion of two Field Experience practicums
