- Tuition & fees – 18% (~\$6.9m)
- Other income (interest etc) – 2%

# Bill 2 - Province of Manitoba

## Protecting Affordability For University Students

- Policy relating to permitted increase in tuition & policy relating to course-related fees
- Regulates tuition fee increases
- Permitted increase in tuition & course-related fees designated as tuition = % change in annual CPI (MB – All items) for the 12-month period ending March 31



# Province of Manitoba Bill 2

## Protecting Affordability For University Students

- COPSE to advise universities by April 15 of the permitted increase
- Universities to advise COPSE of approved tuition fee by May 31 each year
- Mandates the process by which new fees may be approved

# Bill 2 - Province of Manitoba Protecting Affordability For University Students

- COPSE will determine the fee category
- Categories of fees:
  - tuition fees
  - course-related fees designated as tuition fees
  - course-related fees
  - other fees
- Course-related fee increases are to reflect increased cost in providing material or service (cost recovery)
