Authority: *The Brandon University Act.*

Purpose of Collection: To maintain a record for all investigations into, or mediations of, sexual harassment.

Information: Personal information may include; name; home address; home telephone number; gender; marital/family status; student number; race/colour; national/ethnic origin; religion/creed; employment history; disability; attendance reports; absence reports; vacation/leave reports; personal health information; opinions and witness testimonials.
