The Canada-Manitoba Crop Diversification Centre (CMCDC), in Carberry Manitoba is an Industry-Government partnership applied research centre. The centre collaborates on projects with many industry groups within the province, collectively extending new innovations in agriculture to producers. This is an excellent opportunity for any student looking to broaden their knowledge of crop production in multiple crops (including potatoes, industrial hemp, sunflowers, soybeans, corn); gain insight into field research methodologies and expand their network of contacts at the same time.

CMCDC is seeking multiple summer students to assist in various field research operations in Carberry, Manitoba from May 1 – September 1, 2018; these are full time seasonal positions with the possibility of extension, full or part time into fall to assist with data collection.

Each student will be responsible for a specific project and provide assistance with all aspects of agricultural crop field research including planting, trial maintenance, data collection, technology transfer events and centre maintenance. CMCDC provides training and a safe and fun work environment.

Students should be self-motivated, organized individuals who have demonstrated problem solving skills, attention to detail, and can work independently.

- Applicants must have a valid Class 5 Manitoba drivers license.
- Computer skills with experience in Microsoft Excel preferred.
- UAV experience and UAV Ground School certification will be considered an asset.
