To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Possess good organizational and time management skills. Ability to perform assigned responsibilities with a minimum of supervision. Ability to stand, bend, lift heavy objects, walk over uneven ground, and complete physically demanding tasks on a routine basis. PHYSICAL DEMANDS: While performing the

duties of this job, the employee is primarily required to work in the field (e.g., marsh, water, woods, etc.). Field work would likely include wading in shallowly flooded wetlands (chest waders will be provided) and navigating uneven ground with woody or coarse wetland vegetation. The employee is regularly required to sit, talk and listen, as well as must be able to lift and move up to 40 pounds.
