



The expanded and updated Brandon University Healthy Living Centre will be a hub for our students and community to build healthy lifestyles. As the home of the Brandon University Bobcats and innovative community wellness programs, the Healthy Living Centre will be a landmark for the University, the city and the region.

The Healthy Living Centre will be home to:

- The Bobcats men's and women's basketball and volleyball teams
- Regional basketball and volleyball tournaments
- Innovative, community-based therapy and patient recovery programs
- Mini University

The Healthy Living Centre will feature:

- 79,500 square feet dedicated to athletics and wellness – a 49,500 square foot expansion and renewal of the existing 30,000 square foot facility
- Three full-sized gymnasiums
- Four-lane jogging and walking track
- The Great-West Life Cardio Fitness Facility with up-to-date resistance and weight training equipment
- Regional hard court facility with 1,000 spectator seats

The Healthy Living Centre promotes healthy environments and healthy lifestyles, with construction meeting the LEED Silver standard for environmental sustainability.

Build with us

Construction and operation of the Healthy Living Centre will be driven by capital and endowment funds totaling \$24.3 million. Federal, provincial and municipal governments have pledged \$12.4 million and an additional \$6.3 million has been raised from private donors. With these commitments, construction has begun and the Healthy Living Centre will open its doors in 2012.

Your donation will contribute to the remaining \$7 million needed to complete the Healthy Living Centre and fund program expansions to support campus and community.

Legacy Giving / Endowments

What is a Legacy Gift?

A Legacy Gift, also known as a Planned Gift, is a charitable donation arranged during a donor's lifetime but generally not available to Brandon University until sometime in the future. Combined with estate and tax planning, Legacy Gifts can maintain the value of a donor's estate for loved ones while allowing the donor to make a gift without affecting their current lifestyle.

Gifts do not necessarily have to be deferred until the end of one's life to be considered a Legacy Gift. Some donors prefer to make an outright gift to immediately see the impact of their generosity. Any donation of substantial assets given during your lifetime, designed to meet your charitable goals and sometimes to maximize tax or estate planning objectives is also considered to be a Legacy Gift.

In addition to attractive tax incentives, many individuals and businesses want to leave their own legacy for which they will be remembered. Donors may give a designated gift to a particular area of interest or they may choose to give an undesignated gift to help the University with its most pressing needs. Others make a capital gift to help build new facilities or renovate existing structures. Still others create or support endowments for scholarships, research, equipment funds or the library. Methods of giving are as widely varied as the funding interests of our donors, and regardless of the size of the gift, they all have a positive impact on the continued success of the University.

Vale Contributes to Research Project with Aim to Help Northern Manitoba Youth Education

On January 16, 2012 in Thompson, Manitoba, the President and Vice-Chancellor of Brandon University, Dr. Deborah C. Poff met Ryan Land, Manager of Corporate Affairs, Vale Manitoba Operations to accept the company's donation of \$400,000 in support of the Vital Outcomes Indicators for Community Engagement for Children and Youth (VOICE) project. Brandon University is supported in this project through a \$1 million-dollar peerreviewed research grant from the Government of Canada, through the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada, Community-University Research Alliances Program (SSHRC CURA). The University College of the North will share in the award and actively participate in the research activities. The project will also include individuals from Frontier School Divisions, Kelsey School Division and the School District of Mystery Lake.

'This generous donation from Vale will help bring researchers and community-partners closer and make a positive impact in the lives of First Nations and Métis children and youth living in Northern Manitoba," said Dr. Poff. "We are very grateful for Vale's interest and financial commitment to this important collaborative venture in research and capacity-building."

The research activities will be aimed at helping First Nations and Métis children and youth achieve educational and career success. According to John Pollesel, Chief Operating Officer for Vale in Canada: "Vale is very proud to support the VOICE project and to stand alongside the project's many forward-looking sponsors. We believe that every Canadian student deserves a high-quality, inspired education so they can achieve personal and professional success, and Vale is honoured to be part of a project that will see this vision become a reality, especially for Canada's First Nations and Métis youth."

Vale is a global mining pioneer that discovers and transforms the minerals that are essential ingredients in the products people use every day. Vale is the world's second largest producer of nickel, with these operations based primarily in Canada. Canadian operations also produce copper, cobalt, platinum group metals, gold and silver. In Sudbury, Ontario and Thompson, Manitoba, Vale operates mine, mill, smelter and refinery operations; in Voisey's Bay, Newfoundland and Labrador Vale's assets include mine and mill operations. Vale employs about 6,000 people in Canada.


