The title of President Emerita/Emeritus may be conferred upon a President and Vice-Chancellor who has served Brandon University with distinction during her/his term of office. The following criteria will be considered:

1. A President of Brandon University, having served a minimum of five (5) years as President and Vice-Chancellor, shall upon the cessation of her/his Presidential employment with the University be immediately eligible for nomination for the honorary title of President Emerita/Emeritus.
2. Any five (5) members of the University community, including current or past faculty, staff and students as well as members of the public who serve or who have served on Brandon University's Senate or Board of Governors, may nominate a former President for the title of President Emerita/Emeritus. Written nominations, including any supporting documentation, shall be submitted in confidence to the Secretariat of the Board of Governors.
3. The Board of Governors shall consider nominations for President Emerita/Emeritus based on recommendation from the Executive Committee. Any consideration of a nomination for President Emerita/Emeritus shall occur in Closed Session. Only affirmative decisions shall be announced publicly.
4. The title of President Emerita/Emeritus shall carry with it no material benefit other than that of the honour associated with its granting. President Emeriti, however, shall be considered to be honorary members of Convocation.
