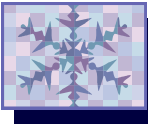

The nature of nursing work in Manitoba predisposes nurses to the development of post-traumatic stress which is associated with an estimated 13% of newly-graduated Canadian nurses intending to leave the nursing profession. We look forward to working with the Workers Compensation Board of Manitoba to identify resiliency solutions and strategies that can be applied during nurses' pre-professional education, and help ensure that the incoming generation of Manitoban nurses are well-prepared for the broadest range of trauma-related issues and challenges in the workplace.

Application Deadline: **WEDNESDAY, MARCH 1, 2017**, (4:00PM CST)

New Investigator Operating Grants

Investigators must be within the first FIVE YEARS of their initial faculty appointment at the Assistant Professor (or equivalent) level in North America, as of the application deadline. Grants will be capped at \$75,000 per year for a maximum of THREE years;

Mid-Career Investigator Operating Grants

Investigators must be within 10 years post Associate Professor appointment in North America, as of the application deadline. Grants will be capped at \$75,000 per year for a maximum of TWO years.
