

Global Affairs Student Research Scholarship Brandon University Application Form

The Global Affairs [Study in Canada Scholarships \(SICS\)](#) enables eligible Canadian post-secondary institutions to award scholarships to students from program-specific eligible countries to undertake short-term research in Canada. Under the supervision of a Brandon University host professor, successful international undergraduate and graduate students will receive a scholarship to conduct a research project at Brandon University. Brandon University has a limited number of research students it can nominate for each program, and candidate selection will be adjudicated by the Senate Research Committee. A complete application package includes:

1. General information form
2. Proof of citizenship: a copy of the candidate's passport or national identity card with a photo and valid dates.
 - documents **not** accepted as proof of citizenship are: driver's license, permanent residence card, work permit, student card, health card, birth certificate or baptismal certificate
 - proof of citizenship selected must be from the same country/territory as the citizenship selected in the online application form
3. Proof of full-time enrollment from the home institution: a letter in English from the home institution, on official letterhead, dated within the last six months, confirming that the candidate is currently enrolled in a full-time program and will continue to be enrolled upon their return. The letter must clearly state:
 - The type of program and the level of study of the candidate at the home institution;
 - The full-time enrolment status at the home institution; and
 - The anticipated completion date of the degree at the home institution.
 - Documents **not** accepted as proof of full-time enrollment are: copies of transcripts, a student card or a letter of admission.
4. Letter of intent from the candidate (maximum one page): outlines the following:
 - Description of research project to be undertaken;
 - Past research experience;
 - The rationale for study in Canada and for the choice of institution, program and supervisor; and
 - How the proposed program of research relates to their current degree and their future career.
5. Letter of support from the home institution (maximum one page):
 - Must be presented on official letterhead, dated within the last 6 months, and must come from the candidate's instructor, professor or international director
 - Explain the nature of research to be undertaken in Canada and how the candidate and the home institution will benefit from this scholarship program;
 - Provide an assessment of the student's research experience.
6. Letter of invitation from the Canadian supervisor (maximum one page):
 - Must be presented on official letterhead, dated within the last 6 months, and signed by the Canadian supervisor;
 - Describes the nature and scope of the research collaboration with the student's home institution;
 - Outlines the research activities to be completed during the research visit;
 - Confirms their willingness and describes how they will support and mentor the candidate during the exchange period;
 - Explains how the Canadian institution, supervisor and peers will benefit from the exchange.

Applications will be assessed based on the following criteria:

- merit of the research or study to be undertaken in Canada;
- alignment of the student's research project with the host supervisor's expertise and research program;
- student's research experience and research potential;
- training plan and benefit to the student;
- benefit to the home institution and peers;
- benefit to the Canadian institution, supervisor and peers;
- strength of the linkages to be created through the proposed exchange;
- alignment of the research project with one or more of [BU's Strategic Research Plan](#) themes;

Global Affairs expects institutions to strive to achieve equitable gender participation and the broadest possible geographic representation. We will be collecting self-identified gender information in support of this requirement. This information will be viewed by the Brandon University program administration staff and may be disclosed to a select number of application review committee members as required; it will otherwise be kept confidential. Applications will be selected based on merit, and gender identity and/or geographical location of your home institution may be considered only to ensure equitable participation where candidates are comparably qualified.

Applications must be submitted to sics-research@brandonu.ca by Friday, March 6, 2026.

NOTE: all application submissions are final. Please ensure to review and confirm details and documents provided in the application are correct and accurate. No changes to the application will be permitted after official submission.
