- Note:**
1. All course work must be in a conferred degree or a recognized vocational teacher education program.
 2. 30 credit hours are considered one year and 60 credit hours are considered two years of course work.
 3. All required years of study beyond secondary school are recognized in the first degree.
 4. All required years of study are recognized in the Bachelor of Education degree.
 5. Additional undergraduate degrees: one step only, regardless of the number of years in the additional undergraduate degrees.
 6. CEGEP from Quebec. Second year of CEGEP is given one step on the salary scale.
 7. Foreign applicants must have completed 12 years of schooling from age 6 to be considered as having Grade 12 equivalency. For each year of deficit, one year is subtracted from the first degree.

Class 4

- a) Secondary education plus four years of study in a degree program, including at least one year of professional study. An undergraduate Bachelor's degree or equivalent is required.
- b) Three year academic degree (B.A., B.Sc., B.F.A.) plus one year of teacher training.

Class 5

- a) Secondary education plus five years of study in a degree program, including at least one year of professional study. An undergraduate Bachelor's degree or equivalent is required.
- b) Four year academic degree (B.A.(Honours), B.Sc. (Honours), B.H.Ec, B. Hum. Ec., B.F.A. (Honours), B.Comm.) plus one year teacher education
- c) Three year academic degree plus a second academic degree plus one year of teacher education
- d) Three-year academic degree plus two-year B.Ed. after-degree.

Class 6

- a) Secondary education plus six years of study in a degree or post-baccalaureate program, including at least one year of professional study. An undergraduate Bachelor's degree or equivalent is required.
- b) Four-year academic degree + a two-year B.Ed. after-degree
- c) Three-year academic degree + two-year B.Ed. + one year in a two-year masters program. **(see Note # 2)**

Class 7

- a) Secondary education plus seven years of study in a degree or post-baccalaureate program, including at least one year of professional study. A Masters degree or equivalent is required.
- b) A person holding a professional teaching certificate and a doctoral degree is placed in this class.
- c) Three-year academic degree + two-year B.Ed. + two-year M.Ed.
- d) Three-year academic degree + two-year B.Ed. + one-year M.Ed. + course work in PhD program.
