

Master of Education: Educational Administration

The Master of Education in Educational Administration enables current and aspiring educational leaders to enhance their leadership capacity. Students will critically engage in contemporary educational issues related to leading for equity, diversity, inclusion and social justice, leading for truth and reconciliation, policy development, culturally responsive leadership, school change, leading in precarious times, and leading for eco-justice. These topics will be taken up in courses focused on the foundations of educational administration, leadership praxis, case law, supervision, and curriculum foundations.

The majority of our Educational Administration “required courses” may be completed on-campus or via distance delivery. The online courses will be conducted via Zoom or Teams and will be conducted synchronously during evening sessions and scheduled based on the Central Standard Time Zone. Attendance during face-to-face and synchronous online courses is required to complete this program. The M.Ed. in Educational Administration will provide the qualifications required for the Manitoba School Leaders’ Certificate. This stream is particularly suited to those educators who wish to become instructional leaders, school administrators or leaders in school systems.
