A minimum degree grade point average (GPA) of 3.0, with no grade below B must be maintained to continue in the Master of Psychiatric Nursing (MPN) Program/Brandon University Faculty of Graduate Studies. A grade of less than “B” on the second attempt will result in compulsory withdrawal from the program. Students who acquire more than nine credit hours below a grade of ‘B’ will be denied further registration.

Student progress will be reported annually via the submission of an annual progress report due by June 1. Students who fail to maintain satisfactory performance as described above may be required to withdraw on the recommendation of the Dean, Faculty of Health Studies and the MPN Program Coordinator. Registration in subsequent courses is contingent upon a satisfactory progress report as assessed by the thesis advisor and approved by the program coordinator. Students may not re-register for a course for which they received a passing grade (B or higher).
