A minimum degree grade point average (GPA) of 3.0, with no grade below B must be maintained to continue in the Master of Psychiatric Nursing (MPN) Program/Brandon University Faculty of Graduate Studies. A grade of less than “B” on the second attempt will result in removal from the program. Students who acquire more than nine credit hours below a grade of ‘B’ will be removed from the program.

Student progress will be reported annually via the submission of an annual progress report due by June 1. Registration in subsequent courses is contingent upon a satisfactory progress report as assessed by the thesis advisor and approved by the MPN Program Coordinator.

Students who fail to maintain satisfactory performance as described above will be removed from the program on the recommendation of the Dean, Faculty of Health Studies and the MPN Program Coordinator.

Students may not re-register for a course for which they received a passing grade (B or higher).

A student who has withdrawn or been removed from the program may reapply at a later date as outlined in the Program Progression Policy.
