

Born in London Ontario Micah Heilbrunn is currently Principal Clarinet of the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra. Micah is a graduate of the Interlochen Arts Academy and received both his Bachelor's and Master's degrees from the University of Michigan. His principal teachers include Jerome Summers, Deborah Chodacki, Robert Crowley and Joquin Valdepenas. Micah has served as Principal Clarinet with the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra, the Royal Winnipeg Ballet, Symphony Nova Scotia and the National youth Orchestra of Canada. Micah has taught clarinet at Brandon University, the University of Windsor and the University of Manitoba and has been heard in live broadcast both on the CBC and National Public Radio. Micah has been an active orchestral and chamber musician playing with groups including the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, The National Ballet of Canada, the Canadian Opera Company and the National Arts Center Orchestra. He has been a featured artist at the Aspen Music Festival, the Winnipeg New Music Festival, Las Vegas Music Festival, the Scotia Festival of music and the Fort Macleod international Music Festival. An advocate of new music he has been a member of the Aspen Contemporary Ensemble, Brave New Works ensemble and has played with Toronto groups Toca Loca and New Music concerts.
