

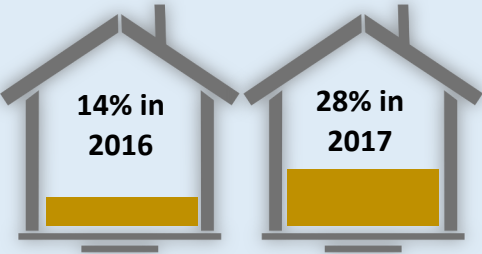

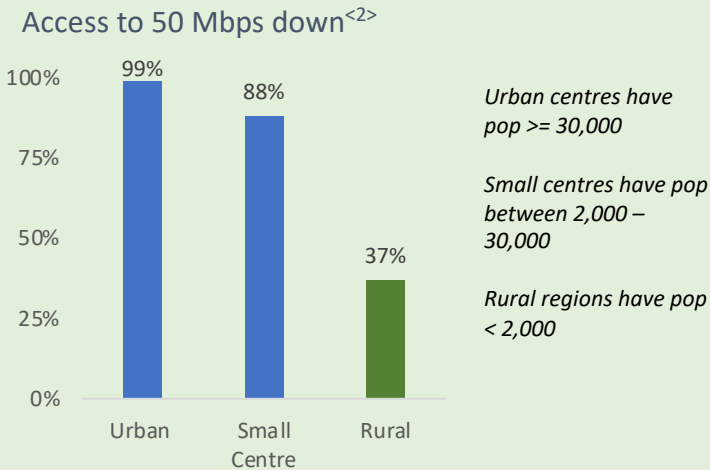
In 2016, CRTC established a new basic standard for broadband: 50 Mbps down, 10 Mbps up & unlimited data

CANADIANS WANT MORE INTERNET

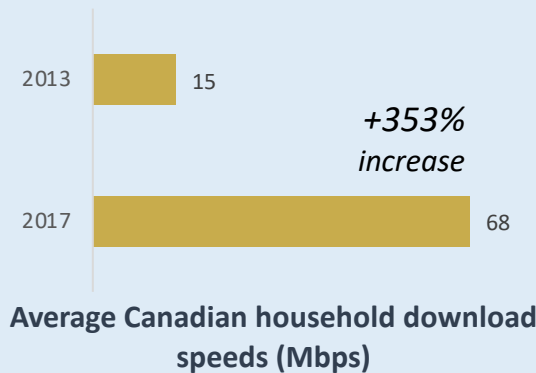


Canadian household subscriptions to 50/10/unlimited service

ACCESS IS NOT EQUAL

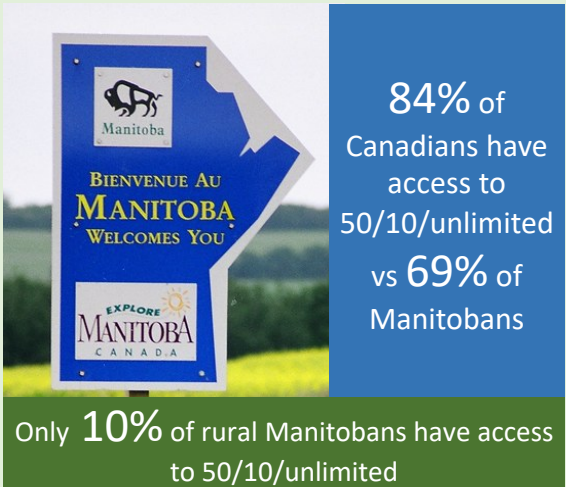


BROADBAND ACCESS QUALITY IS IMPROVING

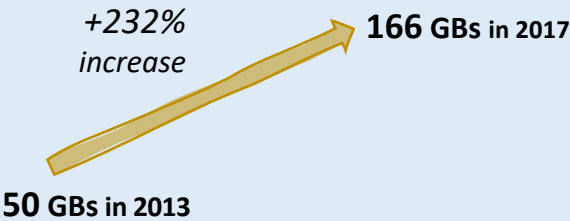


Average Canadian household download speeds (Mbps)

PROVINCIAL ACCESS VARIES

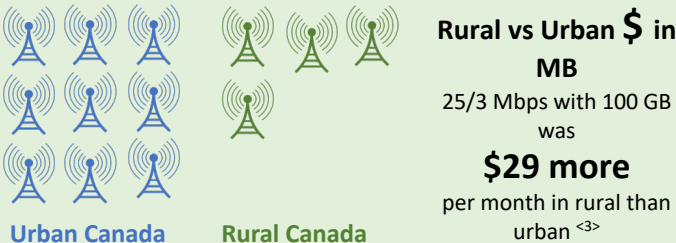


INTERNET USAGE IS GOING UP AS WELL
