1. Commencement hours of examinations are as follows:

MORNING: 9:00 A.M.

AFTERNOON: 2:00 P.M.

EVENING: 7:00 P.M.

TAKE HOME examinations are not subject to the above times but the answer paper must be handed into the Instructor on the day where indicated, unless the Instructor directs otherwise.

2. Candidates must not carry into the examination areas any notes, unauthorized texts or any other extraneous material.

3. Any mathematical tables, texts or other equipment taken into an examination area must not contain any written notes, formulae or other extraneous material.

4. Candidates contravening examination regulations will be required to cease writing and to withdraw from the examination area.

5. Students arriving late may not enter an examination area after the first half-hour.

6. **DEFERRED EXAMINATION** - The University makes provision for students who are forced to miss examinations for acceptable causes such as illness, compassionate reasons, etc. If you are unable to sit for any exam for any valid reason, you **MUST** notify the Instructor at once and no case later than **seven (7)** days after the date of the exam. Your notification **MUST** be accompanied or followed shortly by a **medical certificate or an otherwise appropriate document substantiating the cause of your absence**. In order to write a deferred exam, it is the student's responsibility to make arrangements with the Instructor concerned. A student shall be given a maximum fixed period of time of up to 3 months from the last date of examinations in order to clear a deferred examination.

7. **INCOMPLETES** - An incomplete is granted only on the approval of Instructor, Department Chair and the Dean of the Faculty. It should be noted that an Incomplete is granted only for the deferment of term work, and NOT for the deferment of the final examination.

8. Students who absent themselves from a scheduled examination will be given a grade of NP-No Paper.
