The ORS falls under the Office of the Vice-President (Research & Graduate Studies), a new office as of January 2024. As part of the development of the office, a Knowledge Mobilization Officer (KMO) was hired in November 2024. This position is responsible for leading knowledge mobilization activities, including the promotion of RSF-supported initiatives. Through the KMO, Brandon University will highlight RSF-supported initiatives via social media, digital and print media, podcasts, and institutional events. Efforts will be coordinated to ensure broad and consistent visibility of RSF impacts.
