



Brandon University Residence COVID-19 Protocol (Fall 2021)

The Brandon University Residence COVID-19 protocol is in place to protect all members of the Brandon University Community including all students, staff, and faculty. It is the expectation that all residents understand and abide by the following protocol:

- Masks are must be worn at all times while in Residence except in resident rooms or while eating in the dining room or common areas
- Everyone must maintain a distance of 6 ft. between persons at any one time
- Rules regarding maximum capacity of common spaces must be respected
- Arrows directing traffic flows must be respected
- Only 2 persons may be in the elevator at one time
- Common spaces should be sanitized after every use
- Hands should be sanitized before entering a building or common space
- Residents should self-assess every morning before they leave their room via the online screening tool: <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/>
- Residents should contact the Residence Hall Programs Office if any symptoms of COVID-19 appear and/or have been in contact with a person with a confirmed case of COVID-19
- All must read, understand, and agree to the terms of Self-Isolation Protocol if it is deemed necessary to go into self-isolation for 2 weeks (14 days)
- If permitted under Manitoba Public Health Orders AND Brandon University's Phased Re-Opening, off-campus guests are allowed in Residence. Overnight guests must be signed in online (see "BU Residence Resources" for the link). All guests must understand and abide by the COVID-19 Protocol.
- If permitted under Manitoba Public Health Orders, there is no limit to the amount of people allowed in a residence room. Capacity of guests in residence rooms will reflect most current Public Health Orders.
- It is up to the student to keep up to date with any updates regarding Residence Hall Rules and Regulations, including the COVID-19 Protocol and Self-Isolation Protocol
- Violation of this protocol is grounds for disciplinary measures determined by the Residence Hall Programs Office as per the [Residence Handbook](#)
