Inspect and don all required PPE

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Pre-use	Inspect and don all required PPE. Set up wet floor signs / demarcation as needed.	
rie-use	Ensure no children allowed in working area.	
1.	Use clean water.	
2.	Turn on vacuum, brush, and pump.	
3.	Extract solution by walking backwards, keeping track of where the cord is at all times so as not to trip over it.	
4.	Once carpet is done, empty dirty water from recovery tank. Don goggles and gloves at this time.	
5.	Clean out machine with clean water to make sure nozzles are not plugged.	
6.	Ensure equipment is clean, tidy, and stored properly.	
7.	Place all materials in their proper storage areas.
