This Safe Work Procedure must be reviewed any time the task, equipment, or materials change and at a minimum every three years.

DO NOT perform this procedure until you have been appropriately trained and authorized to do.

Required Training

No loose fitting clothing

Potential Hazards

- Loose knots or foreign materials in wood
- Cuts, lacerations and amputations
- Dust/debris irritation
- Noise

Pre-Operational Safety Checks

- Inspect required personal protective equipment and replace if required.
- Ensure no slip/trip hazards are present in workspaces and walkways.
- Make sure guards, if present, are installed and are working properly.
- Faulty equipment must not be used. Immediately report suspect machinery.
- Locate and ensure you are familiar with the operation of the ON/OFF starter.

Prohibited Activities

Do not leave this equipment running unattended

Safe Work Procedure

- 1. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).
- 2. Make all adjustments with power cord unplugged.
- 3. Adjust angle guide and fence. Ensure that lock lever is secure.
- 4. Set depth of cut based on biscuit size. Mark cutting position on stock and clamp work piece securely to work bench.
- 5. Ensure power switch is in OFF position before plugging in. Check that cord is away from cutting path.
- 6. Turn ON the biscuit joiner before cutting head enters work piece
- 7. Hold biscuit joiner with both hands, align with mark on work piece. Push forward gently to extend blade into work piece until pre-set depth stop is reached.
- 8. Withdraw biscuit joiner to original position and switch power OFF.
- 9. Wait for machine to stop before setting down.
- 10. Clean up dust and debris with POWER OFF.

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, shut the equipment off immediately and follow the lock out procedure.

REPORT ANY HAZARDOUS SITUATION TO YOUR INSTRUCTOR/SUPERVISOR IMMEDIATELY

Housekeeping

- Switch off the machine and reset all guards to a fully closed position.
- Leave the machine in a safe, clean and tidy state.
