One-Year Term Position Department of Geography

The Faculty of Science invites applications for a one-year term position in the Department of Geography at the rank of Lecturer or Assistant Professor.

Responsibilities: The successful applicant will teach up to six courses from the following list: World Regional Geography; Human Geography; Introduction to Geographic Research Methods; Economic Geography; Urban Geography; Cultural Geography; Canada: A Regional Geography; Outdoor Recreation and Tourism; Rural and Small Town Canada; and Population and Development. The applicant is also expected to engage in scholarly activity.

Qualifications: A PhD is preferred; however, candidates with a Master's degree and considerable teaching experience may be considered

Application Deadline: March 5, 2018 or until the position is filled

Start date: August 1 or September 1, 2018, depending upon availability of successful candidate

Salary: Commensurate with the candidate's qualifications and experience
