Assistant Professor, One-Year Term Position - Department of Mathematics and Computer Science

Applications are invited for a one-year term position in the area of Computer Science in the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science, subject to budget approval. The Department offers B.Sc. and B.Sc. (Honours) degree programs with Majors and Minors in Mathematics and Computer Science. Applicants should consult the Brandon University course calendar for more information on program offerings.

Qualifications: Ph.D. in Computer Science or a related field completed or near completion. The successful candidate should have a record of excellence in undergraduate teaching or a clear commitment to undergraduate teaching excellence.

Teaching Responsibilities: The successful applicant should be able to teach 62:264 Digital Computer Fundamentals, 62:306 Systems Programming, 62:371 Database Systems and 62:367 Computer Organization. The normal mode of course delivery is in-person; however, given the uncertainties inherent in the current pandemic, applicants should also be prepared to teach in an online synchronous format. Experience with online teaching would be an asset.

Research & Service Responsibilities: The successful candidate will have the opportunity to apply for internal research funding, to supervise undergraduate honours projects in Computer Science, and to participate on faculty committees.
