## 6.2. Report from the Board of Governors Representative to Senate (Sen. Jolly)

The last meeting of the Board was on January 24, 2015; a number of items were discussed and passed. The sale of University House was approved with 50% of the proceeds to be forwarded to the Centre for Teaching, Learning & Technology and the other 50% to be directed to a fund for a new Science building. The Scholarships that were approved at the last Senate meeting were all approved by the Board. Bylaw #11 of the Board of Governors was revised and only those awards that require funding from the University's operating budget need to be approved the Board of Governors.

Senator Duncan reported that the Minister of Advanced Learning has reported that a new procedure for approving new programs will soon be in place. The institutions will only have to provide the committee with one proposal and the intent is that approval of the proposal should take no more than 120 days. Any proposals that were submitted prior to the changes to COPSE will be assessed before any new proposals are accepted. The University is working on a policy for "Safe Class Rooms".

6.5 Associate Vice-President's (Student Services and Enrolment Management) and University Registrar Report (Sen. Brophy)

No report Sen. Brophy was absent with regrets.

## 6.5 President's Report (Dr. Fearon)

Dr. Fearon reported that the Postsecondary Education Advisory Committee is developing a strategic plan to be released in the spring. The Brandon School Division is looking at adding two new schools in Brandon, there may be opportunities for both Brandon University and Assiniboine Community Collage to partnership with the Division. Dr. Fearon also reported that the international services unit and Faculties/School are collaborating on initiatives associated with MOU's signed in the Fall of 2014 Senate Minutes (Open) Feb. 17/15 Pg. 3

with University and Colleges in China. Due to the success of the Score A Seat campaign the University will be receiving an additional \$250,000 from the Richardson Foundation.
