5.6 Report from the Vice-President (Academic & Provost) (Sen. Robinson)

Senator Robinson reported on the following:

A search is underway for a Canadian Research Chair (CRC) in rural and remote mental health. His office recently recommended five students for NSERC Undergraduate Student Research Awards (USRA).

The decanal search for the Dean of Science has begun.

It has been and continues to be a very busy year with a number of external reviews in process or beginning soon, including the following: Graduate Studies in Education, Physical Education Studies, Gender & Women's Studies, History, Master of Rural Development, Anthropology, Economics, Applied Disaster and Emergency Studies, Geology and Geography.

Dr. Heather Duncan will begin chairing the Senate Research Committee.

Senator Robinson informed Senators that there will soon be an announcement from Brandon University, the City of Dauphin, and Assiniboine Community College (ACC) regarding a one-year pilot project that will give individuals the opportunity to take first-year BU courses in Dauphin. One of the objectives of the project is to offer individuals in the Dauphin area access to

Dr. Fearon reported on the following:

The search for a Vice-President (Academic & Provost) is currently underway. Dr. Fearon thanked the individuals who are currently serving in acting positions.

He made mention of the Walking with our Sisters event that is being held on campus and encouraged members of the University community to continue their active engagement with organizations outside of the University.

He reminded members that Brandon University will be hosting the women's Canadian Interuniversity Sport (CIS) Volleyball Championships from March 11-13, 2016. He also noted that our women's volleyball team has won every game this year. There will be some great volleyball at the event.

His office is planning a General Faculty Council to be held in April 2016.

Dr. Fearon asked Senators to consider the following questions: How does the University consolidate the Academic Plan with Senate policies and the academic process? He noted that Mr. Brophy and Mr. Rowland are currently on international recruiting trip to Thailand. He also noted that he and Senator Robinson have signed a MOU with Jamaica.
